Substance	Handling & Storage	Health Hazards	First Aid Measures
Goo Gone	Tightly closed container. Do not store at elevated temperatures.	Eye: Irritation Skin: Irritation Ingestion: Headaches/ Nauseas Inhalation: Can cause loss of consciousness Harmful or fatal is aspirated into lungs	Eye: Immediately flush with water (seek medical attention) Skin: Flush with mild soap and water. Ingestion: Do NOT induce vomiting. Get immediate medical care Inhalation: Move to fresh air. Give artificial respiration if not breathing
Dry Chemical Fire Extinguishing	Should be properly stored and secured to prevent falling or being knocked over.	Eye: Contact for short periods of time may cause irritation Skin: Mild irritation Ingestion: not expected route of exposure Inhalation: May irritate the respiratory tract/ cause transient cough and shortness of breath	Eye: Immediately flood eye with water (15 minutes) Skin: Wash affected area with soap and water Ingestion: Dilute by drinking large quantities of water and obtain medical attention Inhalation: Move to fresh air. Obtain medical attention for any breathing difficulty
Glidden Color Int/Ext Latex Gloss	Store below 100F. Keep from freezing.	Eye: Irritation Skin: Irritation Ingestion: May cause mouth and throat irritation, gastrointestinal disturbances Inhalation: May irritate the respiratory tract	Eye: Flush immediately with large amounts of water Skin: Wash thoroughly with soap Ingestion: If swallowed, obtain medical treatment immediately Inhalation: Move to fresh air. Restore and support continued breathing.

Sealed Lead-Acid Battery	Normal room ventilation. Keep upright.	Eye: Severe skin irritation, damage to cornea Skin: Irritation, burns, and ulceration Ingestion: May cause severe irritation of mouth Inhalation: Breathing of sulfuric acid vapors or mists may cause severe respiratory irritation	Eye: Flush with plenty of water (15 min) Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and flush affected areas Ingestion: Do NOT induce vomiting. Dilute by giving large quantities of water Inhalation: Remove to fresh air. Give oxygen or artificial respiration if needed
Assembly Lube	Keep container away from heat, sparks, and open flames. High temperatures may produce irritating vapors	Eye: Irritation Skin: Drying of skin Ingestion: Can cause stomach ache and vomiting Inhalation: Heating can generate vapors that may cause irritation	Eye: Flush with plenty of water (15 min) Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and flush affected areas Ingestion: Do NOT induce vomiting. Seek medical attention Inhalation: Remove to fresh air. Give oxygen or artificial respiration if needed

Keep away from heat and electricity	Eye: Irritation Skin: Mild irritation Ingestion: Swallowing may cause gastrointestinal irritation, nausea Inhalation: High concentrations may cause central nervous system effects, and nasal and respiratory irritation	Eye: Flush with plenty of water Skin: Wash with soap and water. Ingestion: Aspiration Hazard. Do NOT induce vomiting. Poison control center: 1-888-324-7596 Inhalation: If irritation is experienced, move to fresh air.

DuPont Krytox Lubricants	Keep container tightly closed. Keep away from heat and flames to avoid decomposition of product.	Eye: Irritation Skin: Irritation/ Prolonged skin irritation may cause redness and inflammation of hair follicles Inhalation: Lung irritation and pulmonary edema which require medical treatment	Eye: Flush with plenty of water Skin: Wash with soap and water. Ingestion: Do NOT induce vomiting. Immediately give 2 glasses of water. Inhalation: If irritation is experienced, move to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen.
TAP MAGIC PROTAP Cutting Fluid	Keep away from heat, sparks and open flames. Keep out of reach of children. Keep container tightly sealed when not in use. Store in cool, well-ventilated place	Eye: Irritation Skin: Irritation Ingestion: May cause vomiting Inhalation: Irritation of the respiratory tract, headache, dizziness, and nausea Note: Repeated/prolonged contact may cause skin sensitization or dermatitis	Eye: Flush with plenty of water Skin: Wash with soap and water. Loctite Adhesive	Keep away from heat, spark and flame. Keep containers closed when not in use. 3mm ABS FILAMENT	Keep dry in a cool place, when the plastic foil is opened store in a container together with a desiccant to maintain product quality.	Unlikely to cause irritation. Medical conditions aggravated by exposure: none expected, based on available information	If any symptoms obtain medical support
Baking Soda (Sodium bicarbonate)	Keep container tightly closed. Keep container in a cool, well-ventilated area.	Slightly hazardous in case of skin contact (irritant), of eye contact (irritant) of ingestion of inhalation.	Eye: Flush with plenty of water Skin: Wash with soap and water. Ingestion: Do NOT induce vomiting. Inhalation: If inhaled, immediately remove the affected person to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen.
Acetone	Store in a segregated, well-ventilated area. Keep container tightly closed and sealed until ready for use.	Slightly hazardous in case of skin contact (irritant), of eye contact (irritant) of ingestion of inhalation.	Eye: Flush with plenty of water Skin: Wash with soap and water. Ingestion: Do NOT induce vomiting. Inhalation: If inhaled, immediately remove the affected person to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration.
